Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences Undergraduate Curriculum Committee Suspension of Admissions – Humanities Honours Program

The Department of Humanities proposes to suspend admissions to the Honours Program in Humanities, and, since there are no students currently enrolled in the program, to phase out the Honours Program immediately. Demand for the Program has not been achieved, and, since without the Honours Program the Department will not need to offer fourth-year level courses, it seems better to devote limited resources to higher enrolling courses at the third-year level.

In accord with Senate-approved procedures for suspension of admission and program termination, the details of the proposed suspension are provided below:

- 1. Impacted credentials: Bachelor of Arts in Humanities, Honours Program
- 2. Campus: Burnaby
- 3. Offered by: FASS, Department of Humanities
- 4. Proposed Date of Suspension/Termination: May 1st, 2017
- 5. Reason for suspension/termination: Low enrollment demand and high cost
- 6. Plan for Suspension and Termination:
 - (a) The Departmental Advisor has already been advised of the Department's intention to terminate this program and has not been advising students to enroll.
 - (b) The decision to terminate the program resulted from discussions during the Department's external review, so faculty members are aware.
 - (c) No students are currently enrolled.
 - (d) No other units are involved.
- 7. Calendar text for the 2017-2018 calendar: The Honours Program in Humanities has been suspended. Students are encouraged to enroll as Humanities Majors.
