Proposal to terminate the BPK Applied Human Nutrition Certificate

Program Title: Applied Human Nutrition Certificate

Department of Biomedical Physiology and Kinesiology, Faculty of Science

Reason for Termination

Admission to the certificate was suspended many years ago (Fall 2012). The main reason for termination of the certificate is that the department does not have the teaching resources to adequately support all of the nutrition courses required for completion. Two of the courses required BPK 111 & 212, have not been offered since Fall 2012 and are concurrently being deleted from the calendar.

There are no longer any students in the program, thus allowing for termination.
