After consultation with Unit Chairs/Directors and Faculty Deans, the external reviews of academic units that were scheduled for the 2020 – 2021 academic year were postponed for a year due to the impact of the pandemic.

The following units will be reviewed in the 2021 – 2022 academic year either on-site or virtually:

- Department of Biological Sciences
- Department of French
- Department of Humanities
- School of Interactive Arts and Technology (site visit to take place in October 2022)
- Department of Mathematics
- Department of Political Science

The mid-cycle reports, including assessment of Educational Goals, are due in the 2021 - 2022 academic year from the following units:

- School of Engineering Science (Deferred from 2020-21)
- School of Mechatronic Systems Engineering (Deferred from 2020-21)
- Department Biomedical Physiology and Kinesiology
- Department of Earth Sciences
- Department of Economics

The external review of the Department of Geography was scheduled for Spring 2020 and was postponed due to COVID 19. The site visit is rescheduled for Fall 2021.
