Program Name Change

Rationale for change:

The Business and Geography Joint Major was created a while ago, and over the past decade has had very low numbers of students. We think the concept of this joint major should be quite appealing for students, but an outdated and unfocused Geography component may underlie the lack of student uptake. The geography component in this program has been revised (Program Change Form submitted) to address priorities in Business education by focusing on Geographic elements of Social Responsibility and Justice, Spatial Analysis Innovation achievable from modern Geographic Information Systems, and Global Perspectives from geographic views of our modern world. The name change proposed here was suggested by the Business Faculty and should better represent what this joint major represents. We are optimistic that the proposed revisions along with the name change will now make this degree more attractive to students.
