RE: Annual Report 2022-2023

I am pleased to submit the Annual Report of the Senate Policy Committee on Scholarships, Awards and Bursaries (SPCSAB) for the fiscal year 2022/2023.

Overview

SPCSAB is the committee charged by Senate with setting policy for the administration of student awards, scholarships, bursaries and other forms of financial aid at SFU. This is primarily for university-administered funding. Three other Senate committees, namely SUAAC (Senate Undergraduate Awards Adjudication Committee), SGAAC (Senate Graduate Awards Adjudication Committee) and SCUH (Senate Committee on University Honors) adjudicate awards to students, where adjudication is needed. Financial Aid and Awards is a unit within Student Services, which processes and administers undergraduate scholarships and awards (entrance, athletic, in-course), needs-based government student financial assistance (Canadian and US), and needs-based bursary and Work-Study programs (for both undergraduate and graduate students). The Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies Office is responsible for the support and administration of major graduate entrance scholarships and awards and other internal and donor funded awards for graduate students.

SPCSAB is not responsible for administering budgets for scholarships, awards, work-study or bursary programs. We include for information, reports from both undergraduate (Appendix 1) and graduate studies (Appendix 2) indicating how funds were distributed. Policy decisions by SPCSAB in the 2022-23 period are detailed in Table 1.
