Subject: Senate Committee Elections

The following Senate committees have outstanding vacancies for election by Senate. Elections, if required, will be conducted on-line following the Senate meeting on Monday, November 3, 2008 for those positions noted below.

Under Senate regulations, any Senator who wishes to submit nominations may do so by notifying the Secretary of Senate in writing (email <u>watt@sfu.ca</u>) of such nominations. Nominations must be received by the Secretary <u>no later than Friday</u>, <u>October 31, 2008</u>. Nominations received after that time will not be accepted. Senators making nominations must ensure in advance that the nominee is willing to stand for election.

As approved by Senate at its meeting on May 12, 2008, balloting for Senate Committee elections will be done on-line. Candidate statements will be put on-line and will be available through a link at <u>http://students.sfu.ca/elections/</u> during the balloting period. Following the November meeting, a web survey ballot will be released with an email announcement to all Senators. Voting will be permitted for approximately 48 hours, and election results will be released within three days of the end of voting.
