Under GGR 1.3.5 the Calendar currently lists seven special topics courses (SAR 891 through SAR 897). These are all listed as 3 credit courses. We have to correct two errors in the current listing, and I would like to propose some minor changes.

## <u>Errors</u>

SAR 896-3 and SAR 897-3 should have been listed as SAR 896-6 and SAR 897-5. These were their original designations, but they were inadvertently changed when the GGR were revised.

### Minor Changes

SAR 891 through 895 are all three credit courses. To increase flexibility in our course offerings, I suggest that we change 893 to a four credit course and 894 to a five credit course. (SAR 893 and 894 have not yet been used by students in special arrangements).
