1. Calendar, p. 248--From:

"Candidates for the M.A. degree at SFU, after successful completion of two semesters and a GPA of 3.5 in 10 semester hours of course-work in the Master's program, may apply for admission into the Ph.D. program"

--To:

"Candidates for the M.A. degree at SFU may, under exceptional circumstances, be admitted into the Ph.D. program without completing the requirements for an M.A., if they have completed 20 hours of M.A. coursework."

Rationale: The GPA listed above is unrealistically low. There seems to be no point in either raising false expectations, on the one hand, or in tying our hands by specifying a higher GPA on the other.

 Change deadline for admission applications to March 1 from Marh 15.

Rationale: (a) March 15 is the deadline for entrance scholarship applications. The Graduate Studies Committee should have admissions out of the way before ranking the scholarship candidates.

(b) Other History Departments tend to have earlier deadlines. Students may tend not to apply here if accepted elsewhere first.
