With the appointment of Dr. J.P. Blaney as full-time Vice-President, Development, effective July 1, 1984, it will become necessary to search for a new Dean. Under the University Act, this search is to be carried out by a Search Committee whose membership and terms of reference have been established by the Board of Governors and approved by Senate. After discussion with Dean Blaney, I propose the following composition and terms of reference for this Search Committee. The terms of reference generally parallel those used in searches for Deans and the Registrar. Terms of reference for the Committee would be as follows:

Members

Conditions

1.	Vice-President, Academic	Chai <i>r</i> man
2.	Two Faculty Deans	Selected by the Deans
3.	Two Program Directors, Continuing Studies	Elected by and from Continuing Studies Program Directors
4.	Three Faculty Members	Appointed by the President
5.	i) One Student	Appointed by the President from a list of no more than five persons submitted by the Student Society.
	ii) One Community Person	Appointed by the President

Terms of Reference

- 1. Deciding whether to include persons outside the University in the search.
- 2. Engaging in a search for potential candidates, examining their credentials, and arranging for appropriate interviews.
- 3. Bringing to the President within a reasonable period of time one or more recommendations for appointment as Dean of Continuing Studies.

This proposal would provide for appropriate representation from the various constituencies affected by Continuing Studies. In particular, the inclusion of persons from the community is an important reflection of the outreach activities of this office of the University.

If you agree with this proposal, it should be presented to the Board of Governors at their June meeting with subsequent consideration at the July meeting of Senate. If both bodies approve, the Search Committee can be formed over the summer and begin its work in September.
