MOTION:

"That the Senate Committee on Undergraduate Studies be instructed to prepare and submit to Senate a policy to deal with the cases of students whose date of graduation may be adversely affected by changes in credit hours granted for courses."

Note:

It is suggested that this policy should operate in the following manner:

Student majoring in Amental Engineering - Course Credits changed from 5 hours to 3 hours

Amental Engineering Department agrees to grant major if student has 27 upper division --> upper division Amental credit hours

Student applies for graduation with 117 credit hours of which 27 are Engineering and 90 fulfill all other degree requirements

Degree Granted

Student applies for graduation with 117 credit hours of which 30 are upper division Amental Engineering and remaining 87 do not fulfill all other degree requirements

Degree Not Granted
