To the Chairman and Members of the Board of Governors of Simon Fraser University, and

I have examined the balance sheet of Simon Fraser University as at 31 March 1981 and the statements of revenue and expenditure and changes in fund balances, expenditures by fund, changes in appropriated fund balances and ancillary enterprise operations for the year then ended.
