The present calendar entry which describes the substitution of Group E courses for Groups A or B is ambiguous. The Faculty of Arts Curriculum Committee at its meeting of July 9, 1981 has approved the following rewording in order to clarify the original intent of the Committee, which was that students could substitute 3 hours in any given group, but for Group A or Group B the remaining 9 hours must be taken from at least two Group A or Group B Departments - i.e., Departments in the Faculty of Arts.

#### CALENDAR ENTRY CHANGE

#### FACULTY OF ARTS

p. 94 From: "Students may substitute up to a maximum of 6 hours of courses taken in Group E, for courses required in Group A, B, or C, with the constraint that a maximum total of 3 hours may be substituted in any one group."

To: "Students may substitute up to a maximum of 6 hours of courses taken in Group E, for courses required in Group A, B, or C, with the constraints that a maximum total of 3 hours may be substituted in any one group, and that the remaining 9 hours in Group A or Group B must be taken from at least two Arts departments. Group E courses so applied will count towards the 70 required hours in the Faculty of Arts."

RATIONALE: To clarify the ambiguity in the present calendar.
