Subject CHANGES IN CURRICULUM, KINESIOLOGY I.S.C. 82-2 Date March 1, 1982.

At a meeting of the Faculty of Interdisciplinary Studies Undergraduate Curriculum Committee held on Tuesday, February 16, 1982 the following items were considered and approved.

- The deletion of CMPT 142-1, Computing Project-'Kinesiology, as a required course for Kinesiology majors.

Rationale: CMPT 103-4 is now a required course for Kinesiology majors, and most Kinesiology students enrolled in this course incorporate a Kinesiology project.

- Change in course number:

KIN. 330-3, Human Energy Metabolism, is to be re-numbered KIN. 430-3. There is no change in the course outline, but it is recommended that students take BISC 301-3 prior to enrolling in KIN. 430-3.

Rationale: This change is intended to reflect the depth of knowledge and standard required of students enrolled.
