"Prerequisite: At least 15 From: credit hours including two of GEOG 111, 121, or 141. Students who have credit for GEOG 161-3 may not take this course for further credit when it is designated as "Europe." Note: This course may not be counted more than once toward the degree.

"Prerequisite: At least 15 To: Students who credit hours. have credit for GEOG 161-3 may not take this course for further credit when it is designated as "Europe". Note: This course may not be counted more than once toward the degree

Rationale:

The department is requesting pre-requisite changes for GEOG. 262 and GEOG. 263 for the following reasons:

- After using two of Geog. 111, 121 and 141 as a prerequisite the instructors teaching these courses have found these requirements as unnecessary. For this kind of course a standing of 15 hours is considered sufficient.
- This change will re-institute the prerequisite situation of 5 years ago.
- There has been a request from Canadian Studies that Geography reduce its prerequisites for Geog. 262. c. By doing this it is hoped that the course will be available to a wider range of students.
