RATIONALE FOR CHANGING AN

HONOURS COURSE REQUIREMENT

- 1. As a course (requirement) designed to increase technical abilities at a fairly fundamental level and to help students analyze data and understand the literature, it should come sooner rather than later in the undergraduate programme.
- 2. Geog. 407 should be a more specialized, advanced course for those with specific interests in geographic techniques or quantitative methods and geographic problems.
- 3. By making Geog. 251 the Honours requirement and clearly establishing this as an introductory and service course I would expect interested non-honours students to register too.
