The following changes are requested by the departmental curriculum committee and we ask that these items be placed on the agenda of the next undergraduate curriculum committee meeting of FIDS.

1. Addition of BICH 440 to the list of upper division options available to students to fulfill requirements in Kinesiology, as part of the nine hours described on page 330.

Rationale: This will enable students to pursue aspects of Biochemistry associated with human movement studies.

2. Kinanthropometry (KIN. 303-3) Change in calendar description from:

> A study of change in bodily form and function associated with chronological use and physiological maturity in relation to genetic and environmental influences.

Rationale: Bioscience 316 has been a "hidden" prerequisite of the Kinesiology program to date. Bioscience has now made BISC 204 prerequisite for BISC 316 making an additional requirement for KIN. majors.
