Action taken by the Senate Committee on Undergraduate Studies at its meeting of November 22, 1977, gives rise to the following motion:

That Senate approve, and recommend approval to the Board of Governors, the proposed change in the wording of requirements for a Major in Kinesiology from:

"For Major students, the Science Core Program specifies that the following courses be taken during the first four levels (semesters):"

to:

"For Major students, the Science Core Program specifies that the following courses <u>must be taken, and will nor-</u> <u>mally be taken during the first four</u> levels (semesters):"

NOTE - Although a student must fulfill all requirements of the Science Core Program, he/she will not be penalized for completing those requirements later than his/her fourth level. The timing will become a matter of clear advice rather than requirement.
