Change Section IV, K. 5

From: The Secretary shall state the names of the persons elected, and reveal the votes recorded. The ballots may be destroyed within one semester of the announcement of the results. Recount may be requested within ten days of the announcement of the results.

To: The Secretary shall state the names of the persons elected. The minutes will reveal the votes recorded. The ballots may be destroyed within one semester of the announcement of the results. Recount may be requested within ten days of the announcement of the results.

Change Section IV, M. 4

- From: The Secretary shall state the names of the persons elected, preferably in alphabetical order, without the number of recorded votes being revealed. The ballots may then be destroyed.
- To: The Secretary shall state the names of the persons elected, preferably in alphabetical order. The ballots may then be destroyed. The minutes will reveal the votes recorded.
- Note: Alteration of the Rules of Senate shall require written notice at a regular meeting of Senate prior to the meeting at which a vote on the proposed alteration is taken, which vote shall require an affirmative vote by two-thirds of the voting members present to carry.
