Action taken by the Senate Committee on Undergraduate Studies at its meeting of November 16, 1976 gives rise to the following Motions:

MOTION 1

That Senate approve, and recommend approval by the Board of Governors, the change in requirements for honors in English as set forth in paper 5.76-156

Note - The Department will not allow courses from outside English to substitute for the honors courses, but the present statement seems to indicate that it will not allow any English course to be substituted. This is not the intention, and therefore the wording has been changed for clarification.

MOTION 2

That Senate approve, and recommend approval by the Bord of Governors, the proposed change in description for English 494-4 Honors Directed Reading from "Supervised reading in a general field for the purpose of isolating a special topic in that field for research toward an honors essay." to "Supervised reading in a general field for the purpose of isolating a special topic in that field for research toward an honors essay. With the Department's approval a student may substitute English 441,443 or 445 for this course."

Note

The addition of the last sentence corrects an omission made in error at the time of a recent curriculum revision.

p. 121 Honors in English Change in Requirements: From "No exceptions apply to the Honors courses, ENGL 494, 495, and 496, and a grade of B or higher must be achieved in the Graduating Essay in which the program culminates."

to: "No courses from other departments may be substituted for the Honors Courses, ENGL 494, 495, and 496. A grade of B or higher must be achieved in the Graduating Essay in which the program culminates."

Rationale:

The Department will not allow courses from outside English to substitute for the Honors courses, but the present statement seems to indicate that it will not allow any English course to be substituted. This is not the intention, and therefore the wording has been changed for clarification.

Change in Description: From: "Supervised reading in a general field for the purpose of isolating a special topic in that field for research toward an honors essay."

to: "Supervised reading in a general field for the purpose of isolating a special topic in that field for research toward an honor essay. With the Department's approval a student may substitute English 441, 443 or 445 for this course."

Rationale:

Due to an oversight the department neglected to include the clause which would allow Honors students to substitute a reading course taken in the Department for the Honors Reading course. This substitution was included in the previous Honors Reading course, but not picked up when the curriculum was changed.
