p. 147 PHIL 331-3

Rationale:

Several courses in the current Calendar have exclusion riders, clauses to the effect that students who have studied a particular topic

in one course may not have credit for that topic in another. For example, the exclusion rider on PHIL 435 reads as follows: "Students may not take this course for further credit if the topic is one which they have studied in PHIL 231, 331, 437, 438, or 439."

In each case where exclusion riders occur, they are out of date. The intention is that they should list all other variable content courses, but none do so now. In our Calendar submission we have added the numbers of the missing variable content courses. Although this may be viewed as a substantial change, it surely is within the spirit of the intent of having exclusion riders in the first place. Indeed, to list only some courses, and omit some others, would be arbitrary and irrational.

PHIL 468-5

The prerequisite should be "Students may not take this course for further credit if the topic is one for which they have credit in PHIL 207, 231, 331, 360, 435, 437, 438, 439, 440, 441, 442, 467."
