To qualify for a minor students must take at least 15 hours of upper division credit in the upper levels in the minor subject; and must take at least three PSA lower division courses (9 hours), two of which should be in the minor discipline."

p.158 Course require-ments in First Four Levels

Students who plan to Minor in PSA must obtain credit for at least three PSA lower level courses, two of which should be in the Minor discipline in addition to the specific upper division courses which constitute a minor.

p.159 Course require-ments in Second Four Levels

Minor Program.

Three PSA courses at the 300 and 400 division in the minor discipline: either Political Science or Sociology or Anthropology in addition to specific lower division requirements listed on p.158.
