Recommended Change

- 3. No more than 15 hours of electives taken in Groups C and/or D may be used for credit toward the degree.
- 3. No more than 15 semester hours taken in Group C and/or D may be used for credit toward the degree except in those cases where a student is enrolled in an approved degree program involving two or more Faculties such as a double major, joint major, joint honors or major/minor degree program.
