The Faculty of Arts recommends that page 59 of the calendar be amended to include this statement on electives:

1. A minimum of 40 hours of the 120 hour general degree program shall be "electives." These electives may be taken from any course in the university subject to the group requirements of the Faculty.
2. a. In the honors program each Department shall be permitted to designate certain courses offered by other departments in the university (including those of other Faculties) as satisfying a portion of the 50 hour requirement in the last 4 semesters in the major subject. Where those courses are at the 100 or 200 level permission of the Dean of Arts is required.
- b. The courses referred to in 2.a. shall be termed "elective supporting courses," and the maximum number of hours of elective supporting courses which would be counted as applying toward the 50 hour requirement shall be 12 credit hours.
- c. Students may select freely from the list of "elective supporting courses."
