Dear Student,

Certain changes have recently taken place in the administration of the Professional Development Program for teachers which I feel should be brought to your attention immediately. The present calendar shows that minimum admission requirements to the P.D.P. have been raised from 45 to 60 semester hours. A more recent change has been the reduction of Education 401 intakes to two per year effective in 1968. Hence there will be no admission to the Professional Development Program in May 1968. It is recognized that this combination of changes may cause some of you considerable difficulty. For this reason we are prepared to make the following administrative adjustments:-

- 1) Students with more than 45 but less than 60 semester hours will be given sympathetic consideration for entry into the Professional Development Program in January 1968.
- 2) The deadline for applications to the Professional Development Program will be extended to December 1, 1967.
