This is to request that the attached course number changes be approved in order to bring three General Studies courses into conformity with the numbers for the new courses we are proposing.

The numbering system we propose for courses in the Centre for the Arts is as follows:-

All courses should have the area designation - Fine and Performing Arts (FPA.). The disciplinary nature of the course should be indicated by the middle digit

1,2,3, or 4-00 General and appreciation courses "Context" courses, general and cross disciplinary 1,2,3, or 4-10courses directly a part of programs 1,2,3, or 4-20Dance courses 1,2,3, or 4-30Film courses 1,2,3, or 4-40Music courses 1,2,3, or 4-50Theatre courses 1,2,3, or 4-60Visual Arts courses Video and such other high-technology arts as may be 1,2,3, or 4-70 Cross-disciplinary courses on criticism 1,2,3, or 4-801,2,3, or 4-90Cross-disciplinary special studies

A single area designation seems most appropriate to the relatively small program we envision, having integration of the arts among its central purposes. At the same time this system appears to offer both sufficient flexibility and sufficient definition for record-keeping and accounting purposes. We recognize that changes in the program over time will mean that some numbers become unuseable, but we believe that 10 numbers per discipline per level should be adequate for the foreseeable future, provided that reasonable flexibility is maintained in those course numbers not tied to a specific discipline.

In the near future, we plan to bring over into this system those courses specifically in dance in the Department of Kinesiology and those arts courses now in General Studies that we plan to maintain. Because of potential difficulities in scheduling that may arise at this time of year, we believe these changes should become effective January 1, 1977. There seems little need, however, to delay the transfer of the three courses specifically designed as part of the arts program that were first offered as General Studies courses in 76-1.
