The Senate Committee on Undergraduate Studies at its meeting of November 4th, 1975 took action which gives rise to the following motion:

#### MOTION

That Senate approve the addition of requirements for a minor in History such that "students intending to enter the minor program must obtain at least nine hours credit in 100 and 200 division course work in History during the first four levels."

Note - Considerable discussion took place regarding the desirability of lower division requirements for minors and, while it was decided to recommend approval for the relatively modest requirements requested by the History Department, SCUS has referred the question of lower division minor prerequisites to the Faculty of Arts for consideration of their general usefulness.
