Grading scheme for KIN 801

- 1) 10% written précis of a presentation by the Chair of BPK. 1<sup>St</sup> drafts will be anonymized, circulated for editing and discussion. Revised version marked with consideration of performance in editing.
- 2) 15% written and edited as above précis of presentation about Animal Research Ethics by the Head of the animal care committee.
- 3) 10% successful completion of CCAC animal research ethics course AND library tutorial on plagiarism (certificate presented to instructor in both cases).

NOTE: successful completion of both these is required to pass the course.

- 4) 25% on Tri-Council Human Research Ethics document. Students will be expected to read the entire document, they will divide it up into equal sections and each will write a précis of "their" section. They will also present their sections in class (PPT).
- 5) 10% précis as above on presentation on Intellectual Property rights and responsibilities
- 6) 10% Class to judge posters at BPK Research Day and to defend their choice of best poster in class.
- 7) 15% arising from 2 writing sessions led by an expert faculty member.
- 8) 5% subjective based on participation.
