Subject: Election Report to Senate (For Information)

The University Act and Rules of Senate require that the Registrar report the results of elections to Senate and the Board of Governors for information.

Student Election to Senate

A call for nominations was sent to all undergraduate and graduate students on January 16, 2012 for sixteen student positions on Senate for term of office from June 1, 2012 to May 31, 2013. The election rules state that there shall be at least one student elected from each faculty and at least three undergraduate and three graduate students among the total number of students elected.
