COURSE DESCRIPTION

These experiences will be the content areas for discussion as well as for the problem-solving collaborative skills practiced by the class sub-groups during the application activities. The instructors will serve in both a lecture capacity and in a group facilitation capacity for guiding the students' reading, writing, skill application, and discussion about collaboration and consultation procedures.
