COURSE DESCRIPTION

Major topics covered in Educ 422 include: A lifespan approach to understanding learning disabilities (LD), conceptual and definitional issues in LD, a language-oriented view to reading disability, visual processing problems, motivational problems in students with LD, metacognition and LD, social aspects of LD.

OBJECTIVES

This course focuses on the conceptual and research aspects of learning disabilities. It is the prerequisite course to Education 424: Learning Disabilities practicum/lab. Educ 424 focuses on providing students with instruction and practice in informal assessment of reading and mathematics problems and remediation of them.
