# EDUC 422 - 4 Learning Disabilities

#### COURSE DESCRIPTION

Major topics covered in Educ 422 include: A lifespan approach to understanding learning disabilities (LD), conceptual and definitional issues in LD, a language-oriented view to reading disability, visual processing problems, reading research and LD, metacognition and LD, and social aspects of LD.

### **OBJECTIVES**

This course focuses on the conceptual, research and assessment aspects of learning disabilities. It is the prerequisite course to Educ 424-4: Learning Disabilities Lab. Educ 424 focuses on providing students with instruction and practice in informal assessment of reading, mathematic and writing problems and remediation of them.
