## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to enable students to plan and implement an elementary school physical education program, as outlined by the Ministry of Education Integrated Resource Package. Sessions will be both theoretical and practical in nature. Specifically the course will focus upon program organization, teaching strategies, and curriculum content in the areas of games, gymnastics, dance and outdoor pursuits. Many practical activities will be introduced which are suitable for use in the school setting.
