**Course Description**

This course will focus on the use of multimedia for curriculum design both theoretically and practically. From theoretical perspective, the course will introduce you to some of the educational, philosophical, and socio-cultural aspects of using technology/multimedia in teaching and learning. From practical perspective, it will provide an in-depth experience for those who would like to integrate technology into their teaching. Throughout the course, the participants will develop a critical understanding of multimedia in education and learn how to use it for curriculum development. They will work on hands-on projects relevant to their interest and the future educational contexts they will be working in. It is hoped that by the end of the semester, participants will be able to both critically evaluate available technologies as they are used in education and use them to develop their curriculum.

**Please note that:**

- this course is not a 'training' course in the use of educational software.
- a basic level of computer literacy is required.
