#### DESCRIPTION

This course will examine the foundations of curriculum development in relation to teaching practice. Participants will examine the historical, social and political forces that influence curriculum. Basic assumptions and beliefs that underlie the various curricula will be studies. One of the primary goals of the course is to help students identify their own philosophy of education and to see how good practice is grounded in good theory. The course will also help familiarize students with some of the contemporary issues affecting curriculum development and teaching practice.
