Art in Society: definitions of art; roles of art; Children and Art Education: children's artistic development; the evolution of institutional art; A Survey of Media and Techniques: Viewing and Responding to Art: approaches to crticial looking; evaluation of children's art; Developing Art Lessons: creative planning and creative learning.
