This course introduces students to the ideas, practicalities, and initiatives that underpin the teaching of visual art.

- 2. To enable students to develop programs in art for particular groups of students as required.

## **OUTLINE OF TOPICS**

Aims of art education; key concepts; BC curriculum; making and appreciating art; art history; children and art; gallery visit; hands-on experience with art media; computer art; photography and video; multicultural art; planning and teaching; evaluation; individual programs; the role of imagination in teaching; some controversies; integrating the arts.

#### REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Completion of art projects 40%
- 2. Critique of artwork from gallery 20%
- 3. Development of an art unit for chosen group 40%
