#### **DESCRIPTION:**

Students will be introduced to the basic philosophies and practices embodied and advocated by art education.

#### **OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. To explore and gain an understanding of artistic ideologies, art production, art appreciation, creativity and contexualization.
- 2. To afford teachers with the theoretical and practical experience necessary for the development of meaningful and diverse programs in art.

## **COURSE CONTENT:**

Art production (printmaking—mono, lino and woodcuts, paper making, batiking, pottery, lowrelief ceramics, collage, drawing and painting, photography and multi-media production); B. C. curriculum; art history; purposes, training and motivation; creativity and self expression; multiculturalism and feminism in the arts curriculum; responding to artworks; the importance of the art gallery; contextualizing artworks and the art experience; planning and teaching; evaluation.

Donald and Barbara Herberholz. Artworks for Elementary Teachers: Developing Artistic and Perceptual Awareness.

Several articles and recommended readings will be given out in class.
