The student will be introduced to the fundamentals of teaching instrumental techniques to elementary school children. The major emphasis of the course will be on how to organize and begin an instrumental program in the intermediate grades. Three approaches to the teaching of instrumental music will be studied, class instruction on similar instruments, class instruction on instruments of related technical background, and class instruction on all instruments in one group. This includes conduction instrumental ensembles (particularly at the beginning level), selected readings, and the study of simple full band scores.
