VIY 6C7 Maximum Enrolment: 20 DESCRIPTION: The purpose of this course is to develop skills in the application of microcomputer technology in the school setting. The objectives are 1) to develop skills in the operation of an Apple II microcomputer; 2) to identify the various modes of computer assisted instruction; 3) to develop skills for courseware selection; 4) to develop an introductory working knowledge of BASIC; 5) to develop an introductory working knowledge of LOGO; 6) to develop skills for modifying existing courseware written in BASIC; 7) to develop skills in the use of application programs such as word processing and file management. <u>Textbooks</u>: Materials may be purchased at the first class. Prerequisites: EDUC. 401/402 or equivalent. Please note: A non-refundable computer user fee of \$20.00 will be collected by the instructor on the first night of classes.
