In place of Educ. 484-8 Curriculum Studies (Trivett), a combination Directed Study Course will be offered.

All students will take Educ. 475-4, Designs For Learning: Mathematics and, in addition, will meet with Professor Trivett separately, to study other aspects of the curriculum. Details of this will be settled during the first meeting of Educ. 475 in July.

The approach used, in the Mathematics and in the other subjects, will be the 'subordination of teaching to learning', and concentrate on reading, language work, some science and social studies, perhaps art and music. Participants will become more competent to function as teachers who can integrate these subjects and to meet pressures of accountability for basic skills in B.C. schools.

Requirements: As for all Directed Studies, students will be expected to work on an approved study both theoretically and practically, with appropriate outlines in the early stages. Grading for the course will take this into consideration.
