INTRODUCTION:

This year Simon Fraser University is offering an unique program in SPECIAL EDUCATION for classroom teachers. The focus will be on helping classroom teachers develop approaches to special needs of children in the regular classroom. It will begin in the Fall with the course, Instructional Strategies for the Special Needs Student. Some teachers who take the Fall course will then have the opportunity to enroll in the Spring Semester course, Education 406 - an Inservice Practicum.

EDUCATION 496-3 - SPECIAL TOPICS:
Instructional Strategies for the Special Needs Student
(September 17th - December 10th)
Every Tuesday - 4:30 to 7:30

This course is designed for classroom teachers who wish to develop a stronger understanding of the special needs of students with 1) serious emotional difficulties
2) learning disabilities. Emphasis will be placed on developing curriculum and shaping instructional approaches which will improve the learning opportunities for students in the classroom. For information, contact:

EDUCATION 406-5 - INSERVICE PRACTICUM
FOR PRACTISING TEACHERS

This is a field-based 5 credit course which allows teachers to implement a special needs project in their own classrooms with support and feedback from an university In-Service Associate. Education 406-5 includes seminars and classroom visits and is graded on a Pass/Withdraw basis. Details will be discussed with Education 496 students in the Fall semester. In order to provide effective supervision, enrollment is limited to 14.

Prerequisites: i) Education 496-3 with Ron Rubadeau (or permission of the Instructor)
ii) A teaching situation with special needs students
