At its meeting of 7 December 2011 the Department of Sociology and Anthropology approved the dissolution of the Certificate in Family Studies. At its meeting of 26 January 2012 the FASSCC approved the suspension of admission to the Certificate in Family Studies. The motion will go before SCUP on 16 May 2012.

Program to be dissolved: Certificate in Family Studies. Final dissolution date is effective of Fall 2012.

Reasons for dissolution of the Certificate in Family Studies: There are no students enrolled in the program. As this program is no longer viable, the SA Department would like to terminate the certificate.
