

SENATE SUMMARY MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 10, 2012

1. Report of the Chair

The Chair welcomed Anke Kessler as a new Faculty Senator and Gord Myers in his new position as Associate Vice-President Academic.

It was reported that the Higher Education Strategy Associates ranked different research universities by performance in two categories (i.e. Social Science and Humanities, Science and Engineering) and SFU was rated in the top ten in both categories.

SFU was admitted this summer into full membership in the NCAA which means that SFU athletes can now compete right across the NCAA, rather than just regionally. This will provide greater opportunity for competition and should build more awareness and support for the Clan within the university. As well, home games are now available to watch on the SFU website.

The SFU vision continues to be utilized in various ways and will be reflected in a community engagement plan that will be going out for consultation in the next few months. The opening of the SFU Public Square will be happening at the Orpheum on Tuesday, September 18, 2012 and all were encouraged to attend. The first annual summit will be around the theme of isolation and disconnection in the urban environment. The Vancouver Sun will be running a series of ten articles associated with the SFU Public Square. The Public Square has also gained support from organizations like the City of Vancouver which has requested that SFU host and facilitates dialogues on their behalf.
