At Simon Fraser University, there are several dates for withdrawing from a class, with varying implications to an undergraduate student's academic record and fee payment.

If a student withdraws from all his/her courses in week 3 of the term, the student will not be eligible to receive any tuition refund; in addition, there is no notation on the student's academic record. A 'WD' notation does not appear on the student's record until week 4 of the term.

Students who withdraw in week 3 often believe they are still entitled to a tuition refund because no notation is noted on the student's academic record indicating they have withdrawn from the course(s). As tuition is no longer refundable, it is recommended that a withdrawal notation (WD) be recorded on the student's academic record. This would align the tuition refund with the withdrawal notation.
