The addition of the minor requirements is in keeping with the current documentation of all admission requirements for other Beedie programs. This will provide clear and consistent information for prospective students and align the SFU Calendar and the Beedie School of Business' undergraduate website.

Student Responsibility

It is the responsibility of each student to be aware of faculty regulations as stated in this Calendar. Departmental and faculty advisors and staff are available for advice and guidance. However, the ultimate responsibility for completeness and correctness of course selection, for compliance with and completion of program and degree requirements and for observance of regulations and deadlines rests with the student.

Undergraduate Programs

Minor Admission Requirements

To be considered for admission to the minor, students must have completed each *lower* division required course with a minimum C-grade. For admission to the minor program within the Beedie School of Business, students will be selected competitively from one of the following two streams.

All courses completed at Simon Fraser University

A portion of the annual admission to the minor program will be selected from students who have completed all of their required courses for admission at Simon Fraser University. Students will be selected competitively based on the grades achieved in the 5 lower division required courses**. Of the required courses, a maximum of 2 of the 5 courses may be repeated for admission. Note that a minimum Simon Fraser University cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 2.4 is also required for admission to the business minor program.

Courses completed at both Simon Fraser University and other post-secondary institution

A portion of the annual admission to the minor program will be selected from students who have completed some courses at Simon Fraser University and some at other post-secondary institutions, including the required lower division courses. Students will be selected competitively based on the grades achieved in the 5 lower division required courses** earned at Simon Fraser University and other institutions. Of the required courses, a maximum of 2 of the 5 courses may be repeated for admission. Note that a minimum Simon Fraser University cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 2.4 is also required for admission to the business minor program.

Business Minor

Admission Requirements

A specific number of seats will be allocated each year to the Business Minor program. Please refer to the admission requirements section Students who have completed the five lower division requirement courses will apply to the Business Minor program, and will be selected competitively based on the grades achieved in the five lower division required courses, with a maximum of two repeated courses on those five lower division courses. Note that a minimum Simon Fraser University cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 2.4 is required.
