On July 7, 2014 the SGSC approved the concurrent Bachelor's – Master's program in the Faculty of Health Sciences. Calendar changes are required for the undergraduate program. The following addition is requested:

NOTE: Students admitted concurrently to a bachelor's degree program and a master's degree program within the Faculty of Health Sciences may apply a maximum of 10 graduate course units, taken while completing the bachelor's degree, towards the requirements of the master's degree and the requirements of the bachelor's degree. These graduate courses must be passed with a grade of B (3.0) or better in order to be used towards the requirements of the master's degree.
