At its October 16<sup>th</sup> 2006 meeting, SGSC approved the following curriculum changes in the Faculty of Education:

a. Minor course changes

**EDUC 845-4 to EDUC 845-5 Learning Mathematics with Computers**

To bring credit hours in line with equivalent courses

**EDUC 946-5 Doctoral Seminar in Mathematics Education**

Prerequisite change

b. Course renumbering

**EDUC 831-5 to EDUC 921-5 Seminar in Philosophy and Educational Theory**

**EDUC 836-5 to EDUC 922-5 Advanced Seminar in Epistemology and Education**

Education uses 900 numbers for PhD courses, and this reflects the new PhD stream in Philosophy of Education

c. New stream to PhD program in Curriculum Theory and Implementation: **Philosophy of Education**

This stream has the same general requirements as Curriculum Theory and Implementation, and substitutes two courses in Curriculum Theory with two courses in Philosophy of Education.
