At its March 1997 meeting, Senate approved a motion from the Senate Committee on Academic Planning to extend the 7% limit on admission of international students to SFU for a period of three academic years (1997/98 to 1999/00). The attached table shows the actual number of international students who registered in each semester throughout this period.

The Senate Committee on Enrollment Management and Planning met on February 2, 2000 and agreed that the 7% limit should be extended for another three years.
