Subject: Breadth Requirements

The Curriculum Revision Sub-Committee recommends that, contingent on the approval the proposed division of the Department of Languages, Literatures and Linguistics, the Faculty of Arts Breadth Requirements be modified as follows.

Deletion of the following entries under the list of "departments" from among which the breadth requirements may be fulfilled:

"Latin American Studies (LAS)
Languages, Literatures and Linguistics (includes all of:
CHIN, FREN, GERM, GRE, ITAL, LATN, LING, LIT, RUSS,
SPAN)"

Addition of the following entries:

"French (FREN)"
"Linguistics (LING)"
"Spanish and Latin American Studies (includes SPAN
and LAS)."

This recommendation follows from the need to adjust the Faculty breadth requirements to accord with the prevailing structure of departments within the university. One effect of this change will be to exclude non-program languages, such as Chinese and Russian, from inclusion within an identified department. However, the breadth requirements permit students to count courses not clearly within departments by permission of the Dean of Arts Office. Such permission will be given routinely for language courses where the student's record demonstrates a reasonable distribution of work outside language instruction.

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
