Change in prerequisites for PSYC 210-3 -

FROM: PSYC 201 and one of the B.C. High School Math 12 courses
or MATH 100 or equivalent

TO: PSYC 201 and one of the B.C. High School Math 12 courses
or MATH 100 or equivalent. Students without one of the
B.C. High School Math 12 courses should enrol in MATH 110
rather than MATH 100.

p. 199 PSYC 210 Data Analysis in Psychology

Change of Prerequisites only

FROM: PSYC 201 and one of the B. C. High School Math 12 courses or MATH 100 or equivalent

TO: PSYC 201, and one of the B. C. High School Math 12 courses or Math 100 or MATH 110 or equivalent. Students without one of the B.C. High School Math 12 courses should enrol in MATH 110 rather than MATH 100.

RATIONALE: The Math Department has instituted a new MATH course, MATH 110, specifically for Business and Social Science students which requires Algebra 11 only. It should be included in the calendar as an appropriate option for students preparing for PSYC 210.
